MEMORANDUM FOR DARRELL TRENT

FLORIDA:

Right now it looks as though Lou Frey will be as important to us as anyone else in Florida. We should give him the advantage of our associates. The main focus (W. J. D.) is still in the area of the Florida Central Commission districts and the main focus property is in Lou Frey's district. They should eventually be moved into the jurisdiction of this property.

Under Murray is the chief matter you have to be careful with in Florida. The main thing is cooperation next year or next if it is possible. Let me want it on our terms. Any way this can be a history of what we're doing but out those little people in the line it would be a success.

UNITED STATES:

The present situation, I believe, is very close to us and we should be in a position to indicate that we should have all other things to indicate the main apparatus into the situation, which would be a success. It is hard to be worked into the transfer of these two properties if at all possible.

Under Murray, the main thing is to have the main apparatus to the courts and to have the main apparatus. There are no other things that we want it, so you should try to get it in on some of the things.

MEMORANDUM FOR DARRELL TRENT

FLORIDA:

Right now it looks as though Tom Frey will be as important to us as anyone next year in Florida. We should give him the advantage wherever possible. Of the four pieces of Florida real estate in question, three are in Democrat Congressional districts and the Orange County property is in Lou Frey's district. They should definitely be worked into the dedication of this property.

Senator Gurney is the other factor you have to be careful with in Florida. We want Gurney's cooperation next year because it can be helpful. But we want it on our terms. Any way this can be reinforced when we're handing out these little goodies to him like this would be desirable.

PUBLIC RICO:

The present Governor, Luis Ferré, is very close to us and must run again in '72. He indicates that a second term will allow him to integrate his party apparatus into the statewide GOP, which would be desirable. Ferré ought to be worked into the transfer of these two properties if at all possible.

Carlos Romero, the Mayor of San Juan, is reputedly the heir apparent to the Puerto Rico GOP when Ferré steps down. Ferré acknowledges this and wants it, so you might try and work Romero in on some of this.

ILLINOIS:

This piece of property is in Danborn's district, so he should be part of the picture along with Silvie and Percy, if they are interested. It is important to work this project through Tom Houser, who is our man in Illinois and just beginning to get set up. A little project like this will show he has some clout and help him get established.

NEW JERSEY:

The one piece of property is in a Democrat district. Governor Cahill looks good and probably his office should be consulted on this.

NEW YORK:

This property is in a Democrat district. Go with Rockefeller to get the most mileage and to keep out of trouble between the two Senators.

WASHINGTON:

The property is in Brock Adams' district, a Democrat. Work with Governor Dan Evans. He's all we've got.

TEXAS:

Again, property is in a Democrat district. The most mileage can be obtained for us by working through Senator Tower.

CALIFORNIA:

The property is in a Democrat Congressional district. Go with Reagan.

COLORADO:

It appears that some of this property is in Don Brotzman's district, so he is going to have to be included. Senator Allott has to be given preference because he's on the line next year. Senator Dominick and Governor Love should also be consulted on the arrangements, however.

TENNESSEE:

The property appears to be in a Democratic Congressional district. Senator Baker should be given the opportunity to run with the ball, but Brock has to be consulted.
