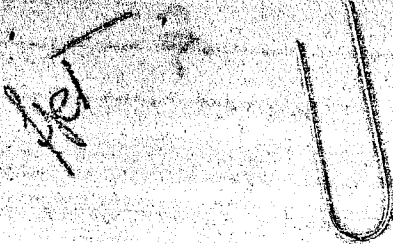


Dear Mr. Gray:
