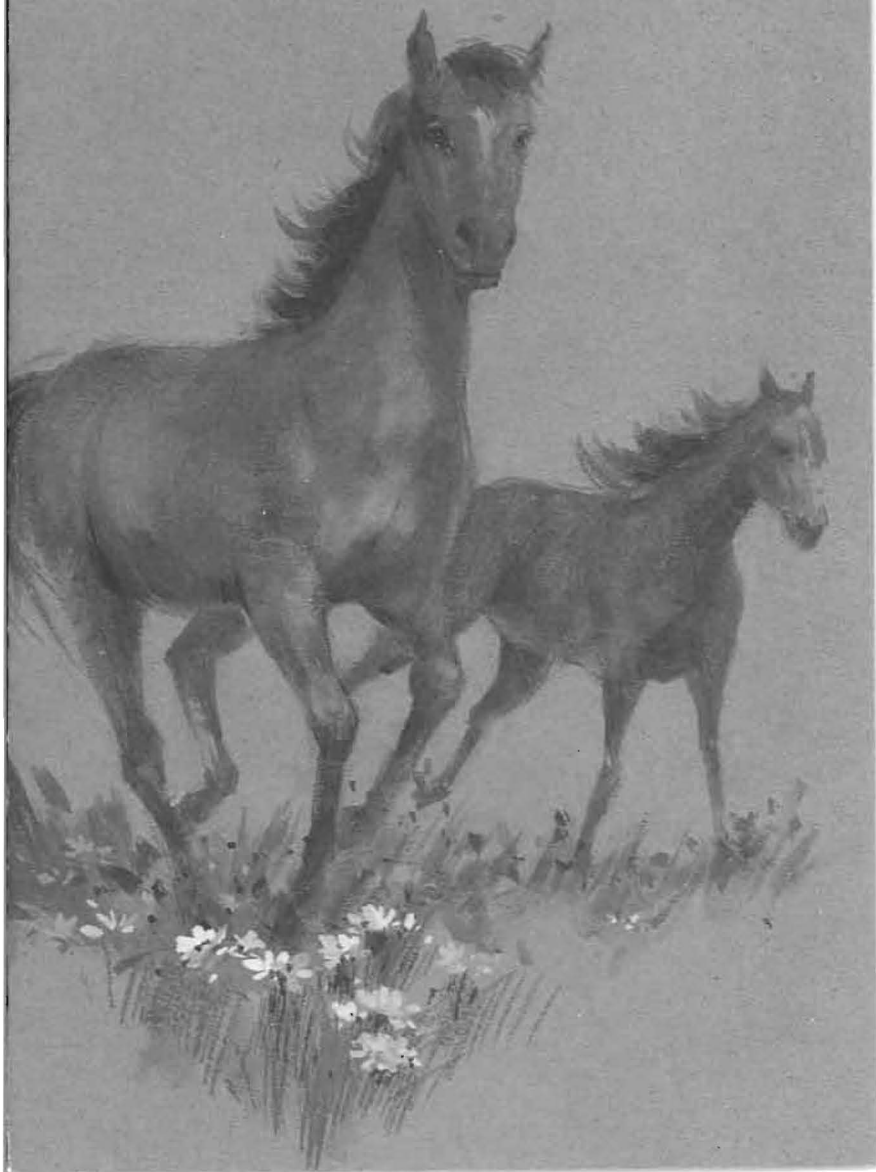

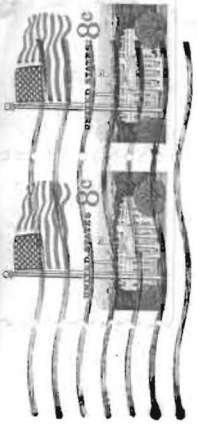

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, MR. PRESIDENT:

Whom God rewards he often puts to test,  
That he may see the mettle of the man who's best,  
To serve the purpose of His plan for earth.  
And without fanfare grants him noble birth.

Then as that man develops through the years,  
God gives him burdens and evokes his tears.  
The trials which are at our God's behest,  
Are those which make that man one of the blest.

No matter what contrivance others use,  
To try that man and daily him abuse,  
His staunchness will survive the trial,  
No fear has he of others use of guile.

Now that you've reached the age of sixty-one,  
God has declared to all, you are His son.  
Of His great blessings He will grant you more,  
Now that you've been tried in the past three score.

Here is my prayer that true, and just reward,  
Will come to you from Him, who is our Lord.


