she go overseas to teach as she had done - So
Kathryn had filed out the application and
is writing to Mr Watson and Mr Thurmond
for a little help - since these applications were
supposed to have been filed in January. I
have also written to each asking them their
support and help since it is almost April.
I believe this comes under the Secretary of
Defense. We will certainly appreciate any help
you can give us on this.
