#### PURPOSE I.

To receive a briefing from the Congressional Campaign Committee on key 1970 House races.

#### BACKGROUND

- The lineup of the House is presently 245 Democrats, 186 Republicans and 4 vacancies. One vacancy is the 6th District of Illinois (Ronan's seat), two are the 24th and 35th of California (Lipscomb and Utt), and the other is the 6th District of New Jersey (Cahill).
