SUBJECT: Jim Brown

I hope notedy is operating under the assumption that Ilm Brown is a particularly popular figure in the black community and will, therefore, be especially valuable in the black vote effect. From what I can figure, many blacks regard Brown so being arrogant and self-sentered. Black women, in particular, are reported to dislike Brown and recent his being paired with white women in his films (as in his most recent film, films).

Therefore, it may be counterproductive to the black vote effort to use Brown in ode aimed at the black community. Brown may be, in fact, more palatable to whitee than to blacke (as is true for people like Lianal Hampton, and even, to a degree, Sammy Davie).

The above are my own subjective reflections and certainly cannot be proven in an empirical faction. Monotheless, I think it is comothing wouth begging mind as a potential source of difficulty.
