Now I realize he may have an unknown reason for this particular project, but based on my own photographic know-how, unless there are special considerations, this is a waste of time for us to produce photographs such as this which will probably never see the light of day.

I would strongly recommend that if any change in the operations over there is being considered, that this be included.
