In New Jersey, last year, Bruce Palmer accepted this assignment and we automatically had the top drawer Mutual Benefit Life agents to call upon to head the operation in their commuunities. High grade life insurance men are a 'natural' for this type of operation and if, in addition, they have the boss to please, it is a sure winner. Such a chairman should also accept the responsibility of getting under-writing funds for publishing the book and other intital expenses, pending the receipt of funds raised by the local operations.
