Scope and Content

NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL FILES

These Presidential historical materials are in the custody of the National Archives and Records Administration under the provisions of Title 1 of the Presidential Recordings and Materials Preservation Act of 1974 (44 U.S.S. 211 note), and implementing regulations. In accordance with the act and regulations, archivists reviewed the file group to identify private or personal as well as non-historical items. Such items, if found, have been withdrawn for return to the individual with primary proprietary or commemorative interest in them.

Materials covered by this act have been archivally processed and are described in this finding aid. Items that are security classified or otherwise restricted under the act and regulations have been removed and placed in a closed file. A Document Withdrawal Record (NA Form 1421) has been placed in the front of each folder describing each withdrawn item. Employees of the National Archives will review periodically the unclassified portions of closed materials for the purpose of opening those which no longer require restrictions. Classified documents may be reviewed for declassification under authority of Executive Order 12958 in response to Mandatory Review Requests (NA Form 14020) submitted by the researcher.

REMOTE ARCHIVES CAPTURE PROJECT FILE

The Remote Archives Capture Project (RAC) contains scans of documents opened in whole or in part by the Remote Archives Capture declassification program from those collections that are not yet open for research or were exempted from declassification during initial processing. Under the RAC Project, over 490,000 pages of documents at the Nixon Library were scanned and transmitted to Washington for declassification review. Periodically, the reviewed material is returned to the Library and processed by Library staff as part of our on-going declassification efforts.
