

THE UNITED STATES HAS SCRUPULOUSLY OBSERVED ALL THE PROVISIONS OF THE CEASEFIRE. ON FEBRUARY 23 THE U.S. ON ITS OWN NOTIFIED THE NORTH VIETNAMESE SIDE OF THE ACCELERATION OF THE MIND SWEEPING OPERATIONS. ON FEBRUARY 26 THE U.S. ON ITS OWN INFORMED THE NORTH VIETNAMESE THAT THE UNITED STATES HAD MADE STRONG REPRESENTATIONS IN SAIGON AGAINST THE ACTS OF VIOLENCE COMMITTED AGAINST MEMBERS OF THE NORTH VIETNAMESE DELEGATION TO THE FOUR-POWER COMMISSION. IN THE COURSE OF PRIVATE MEETINGS OF SPECIAL ADVISOR LE DUC THO AND MINISTER XUAN THUY WITH DR. HENRY A. KISSINGER, THE DRVN SIDE HAS REPEATEDLY POINTED OUT THAT TO ITS KNOWLEDGE THE NUMBER OF US MILITARYMEN CAPTURED IN LADS WAS A VERY SMALL ONE, OF ONLY 5 OR 6 MEN. 1, FOLLOWING ARE THE CHANGES IN PROTOCOLS AGREED TO TODAY IN MY MEETING WITH THACH.

(1) IN THE ICCS PROTOCOL (ART. 14 (C)), WE AGREED ON FOUR AND ONE HALF MILLION FRANCS AS THE AMOUNT OF INITIAL CONTRIBUTION BY EACH PARTY TO THE ICCS BUDGET.

(2) IN THE PRISONER PROTOCOL, WE ADDED THE FOLLOWING NEW PARA. (C) TO ARTICLE 7: QOUTE WITHIN FIFTEEN DAYS AFTER THE SIGNATURE OF THE AGREEMENT, THE TWO SOUTH VIETNAMESE PARTIES SHALL EXCHANGE LISTS OF THOSE VIETNAMESE CIVILIANS CAPTURED AND DETAINED BY EACH PARTY AND LISTS OF THE PLACES AT WHICH THEY ARE HELD. END QOUTE.

(3) ALSO IN THE PRISONER PROTOCOL, THACH FINALLY ACCEPTED A FORMULA ALONG THE LINES WE HAD PROPOSED FOR ARTICLE 9

(A) TO CONTRIBUTE TO IMPROVING THE LIVING CONDITIONS OF THE CAPTURED MILITARY PERSONNEL OF THE PARTIES AND FOREIGN CIVILIANS OF THE PARTIES, THE PARTIES SHALL, WITHIN 13 DAYS, AGREE UPON THE DESIGNATION OF THO OR MORE NATIONAL RED CROSS SOCIETIES TO VISIT ALL PLACES WHERE CAPTURED MILITARY PERSONNEL, THE PLACES WHERE CAPTURED MILITARY PERSONNEL, AND FOREIGN CIVILIANS ARE HELD.

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

WHEN I CALLED CUSTOMER AND PROPOSED URGENT
MEETING HE SUGGESTED 1030 AS THE EARLIEST HOUR
HE COULD MAKE IT. I ACCEPTED AND DELIVERED THE
MESSAGE CONTAINED IN YOUR WHP 436.

HE READ THE MESSAGE VERY CAREFULLY A COUPLE OF TIMES. HE THEN ASKED IF I WOULD CONSIDER HIS REMARKS AS A PERSONAL COMMENT BETWEEN THE TWO OF US ADDING THAT HE COULD NOT OF COURSE COMMENT ON A MESSAGE BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND HIS PRIME MINISTER. I AGREED.

HE SAID IN EFFECT THAT ONE SHOULD APPRECIATE THE DIFFICULTIES INVOLVED IN FINDING PILOTS WHO WERE YOU MUST UNDERSTAND, HE ADDED, DOWNED IN LADS. THAT WE HAVE THE BEST OF INTENTIONS AS WE HAVE ALREADY PROVEN DURING THE NEGOTIATIONS, BUT THERE ARE REAL PRACTICAL PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH THE RECOVERY OF THESE PEOPLE. THERE WERE INSTANCES WHEN BOTH SIDES SEARCHED IN VAIN AFTER AN AIRCRAFT HAD BEEN OBSERVED GOING DOWN. THE BRUSH IS A LONG WAY FROM CIVILIZATION AND LADS IS SCARCELY POPULATED. I REPLIED THAT EVEN UNDER THE WORST CONDITIONS POSSIBLE IT WAS DIFFICULT TO ACCEPT THE FACT THAT ONLY TEN PEOPLE HAD BEEN IDENTIFIED. THAT EVEN ON A PERCENTAGE BASIS, HE SHOULD UNDERSTAND IT WOULD BE DIFFICULT FOR ANYONE TO BELIEVE THE FIGURE PRESENTED. AFTER ALL, THESE MISSING PRISONERS COULD NOT ALL BE CONSIDERED AS VICTIMS OF AIRCRAFT FAILURES OVER VIRGIN FOREST AREAS. I ADDED THAT IT SEEMED TO ME THAT THEIR FRIENDS IN LADS COULD CERTAINLY BE BROUGHT TO A HE REPLIED THAT THERE WERE GREATER EFFORT. HE SAID, I HAVE BEEN ASKED BY OUR SIDE TO TELL YOU THAT WE PROPOSE THAT THE LIST OF PRISONERS. WHICH WE PASSED TO YOU NOT BE MADE PUBLIC BEFORE A SOLUTION TO THE LADS PROBLEM.

I TOLD HIM I COULD NOT COMMENT ON THEIR PROPOSAL

BUT WOULD PASS IT ON TO WASHINGTON.
IN ANSWER TO MY QUESTION, HE SAID THAT HAND! HAD PROMISED TO FURNISH HIM THE TECHNICAL DATA CONCERNING THE HANDI TRIP SOMETIME TODAY. I ASKED HIM IF HE EXPECTED TO BE ABLE TO FURNISH THE INFORMATION TODAY. HE WAS COMPLETELY RELAXED AND DID NOT GIVE ME
THE IMPRESSION THAT HE WAS REPEATING PRE-RECORDED
MUSIC. HIS FREQUENT INSISTENCE THAT HIS COMMENTS. WERE PERSONAL AND NOT OFFICIAL MAY HAVE BEEN SINCERE BUT I AM SKEPTICAL IN VIEW OF THE NUMBER OF TIMES AMBASSADOR SULLIVAN AS WELL AS HAY ISHAM HAS RAISED THE ISSUE. THE ENTIRE SESSION WAS CORDIAL AND RELAXED BUT HE STILL DID NOT SERVE TEA. MAYBE WE HAVE ONE WHO DOESN'T LIKE IT. WARM REGARDS. END MESSAGE

1. PLEASE REQUEST A MEETING TO DELIVER THE FOLLOWING NOTE AND

ASK THAT IT BE CONVEYED TO LE DUC THO.

BEGIN TEXT: THE U.S. SIDE WISHES TO EXPRESS THE SERIOUS VIEW IT TAKES OF THE FAILURE OF THE NORTH VIETNAMESE SIDE TO PRODUCE A LIST OF AMERICAN PRISONERS HELD IN LAGS. GIVEN THE CONSTANT POSITION OF THE U.S. WITH RESPECT TO ITS PRISONERS AND THE MESSAGES EXCHANGED BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND THE PRIME MINISTER OF THE DRY IN OCTOBER, THE NYN SIDE WAS BOUND TO KNOW THAT THE U.S. SIDE WOULD INSIST ON THE SAME PROCEDURES FOR LAGS AS FOR VIETNAM. WHILE IT IS TRUE THAT PROCEDURES FOR DEALING WITH PRISONERS IN LAGS WERE NOT EXPLICITLY PART OF THE FORMAL AGREEMENT, IT WILL BE VERY DIFFICULT TO BELIEVE THAT THE NORTH VIETNAMESE SIDE IS APPROACHING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT WITH GOOD WILL IF THE LIST IS NOT FORTHCOMING IMMEDIATELY. IT MUST ALSO BE CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD THAT FAILURE TO SOLVE THIS ISSUE MUST HAVE THE EFFECT OF IMPAIRING THE UTILITY OF DR. KISSINGER'S VISIT TO HANDI, BECAUSE IT WILL RESTRICT HIS ABILITY TO DISCUSS POSITIVE PROGRAMS. THE U.S. SIDE ALSO WISHES TO POINT OUT THAT, AS POINTED OUT IN ITS MEMORANDUM OF JANUARY 23, IT ASSUMES THAT SOME U.S. PRISONERS WILL HAVE BEEN RELEASED PRIOR TO DR. KISSINGER'S ARRIVAL IN HANDI. THE LIST OF AMERICAN PRISONERS HELD IN LADS BEGIN TEXT: WHICH WAS PRESENTED IN PARIS ON FEBRUARY 1, 1973, IS UNSATISFACTORY. U.S. RECORDS SHOW THAT THERE ARE 317 AMERICAN MILITARY MEN UNACCOUNTED FOR IN LADS AND IT IS INCONCEIVABLE THAT ONLY TEN OF THESE MEN WOULD BE HELD PRISONER IN LADS.

THE UNITED STATES SIDE HAS ON INNUMERABLE OCCASIONS MADE CLEAR ITS EXTREME CONCERN WITH THE PRISONER ISSUE. THERE CAN BE NO DOUBT THEREFORE THAT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ANY AMERICAN UNDERTAKING IS
RELATED TO THE SATISFACTORY RESOLUTION OF THIS PROBLEM. IT SHOULD ALSO
BE POINTED OUT THAT FAILURE TO PROVIDE A COMPLETE LIST OF PRISONERS
