Please deliver the following message to your customer when you see him today at 2300 Paris time October 14, 1972:

"The U.S. side has read with the greatest care the message delivered to the U.S. liaison offer at 11:00 a.m. Paris time on October 14, 1972.

"The Democratic Republic of Vietnam party must understand, as Dr. Kissinger pointed out, that the U.S. side has made its maximum concessions throughout the document and that attempts to go further would jeopardize the schedule agreed to by both sides.

that this issue is of great significance and involves the deepest feelings and will do its maximum to find a solution. As indicated by Dr. Kissinger, the U. S. side has been carefully studying this issue for a fresh approach in addition to the substantial changes already made in the U.S. position on this subject during the private meetings of October 8 through 12. Just as the DRV side has pointed out that it cannot take obligations with respect to some of its friends, so it is impossible for the U.S. side to go further than what it can reasonably state will be implemented before the agreement has even been discussed in Saigon. To show its good will and serious

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attitude and to facilitate the conclusion of the negotiations the U.S. is prepared to add the following sentence to the end of paragraph c) of Article 8 in the U.S. draft left with the DRV side on October 13.

"Quote: The two South Vietnamese parties will do this as soon as possible and do their utmost to resolve this question within three months after the ceasefire comes into effect. Unquote.

"In addition, the U.S. side will give the DRV side verbal assurances that it will exert its maximum efforts in Saigon to help bring about a resolution of this issue in the time period indicated and in the spirit set out in paragraph c) of Article 8.

"The U.S. side wishes to point out that an acceptance by the DRV of the changes communicated to the DRV on October 13 and 14 is crucial if the agreed upon schedule is to be kept. The U.S. side wishes to reiterate that it will approach the meeting on October 17 with the firm intention of completing a final text so that the visit to Hanoi can concentrate on the new era of bilateral relations. The U.S. side therefore hopes that the DRV side will show an understanding and forthcoming attitude as well."

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AT THE PRIVATE MEETING OF 2 MAY 1972, THE AMERICAN SIDE GAVE TO THE DRV SIDE A DOCUMENT WHICH ALLEGED THAT THE RDV SIDE WAS ATTEMPTING TO "EXPLOIT THE PRIVATE CHANNEL AND ASSOCIATE IT WITH MILITARY TACTICS". THE ROY SIDE REJECTS THESE ASSERTIONS AS UNREASONABLE AND WITHOUT CUMDATION.

A) DURING THE WORK OF THE PARTS CONFERENCE AND EVEN BEFORE, DURING THE PRIVATE MELTINGS AND AFTER, THE UNITED STATES HAS NOT CLASED TO EXERCISE A MILITARY PRESSURE ON THE VIETNAMESE PEOPLE TO ORDER TO NIGOTIATE FROM A "POSITION OF FORCE". (UNDERLINED).

THE FIRST PRIVATE MELTING WAS ON 4 AUGUST 1969, THE UNITED STATES LAUNCHED AN OFFLASIVE IN THE PLAINS OF JARRES-XIENG KHOANG.

WHILE THE PRIVATE MELTING OF 21 FLORWARY 1978, OF 16 MARCH 1972 AND THOSE OF 4 APRIL 1972 WERE BEING HELD, THE UNITED STATES COUNTED THE 13 MARCH 1972 COUP D' ETAT IN CAMBODIA. FOLLOWING THAT, ON 32 APRIL 1972, THEY DENT TROUPS TO AGGRESS THIS COUNTRY AND FROM THE FIRST TO 4 MAY 1978, THEY CONDUCTED BOMBARDMENTS AGAINST MORTH VIETNAM. AGAINST WORTH VIETNAM.

- SHOKILY AFTER THE TWO PRIVATE MEETING HELD DURING SEPTEMBER 1978, THE UNITED STATES ONCE AGAIN CONDUCTED VIOLENT AND AERIAL SUMBARDMENTS AGAINST NURTH VIETNAM, AND IM-PUDENTLY MUUNTED A COMMANDO OPERATION WITH THE HOPE OF SECURING AMERICAN PRISONERS OF WAR. THE AIR ATTACKS CONTINUED UNTIL 20 MOVEMBER 1978.
