# **Scope and Content Note**

The Nixon Library has compiled the following list of correspondence and interactions between Richard Nixon and other Presidents of the United States before, during, and after Richard Nixon and the other Presidents were in office.

The Presidents, with whom Richard Nixon interacted, range from Herbert Hoover to Bill Clinton. The sources below contain objects that reveal the close relationships between various U. S. Presidents, members of the "World's Most Exclusive Fraternity," according to the recent book by Nancy Gibbs and Michael Duffy entitled *The Presidents Club*. The collection ranges from advice given to Representative Nixon by Herbert Hoover, whom Nixon affectionately calls "Chief," to George H. W. Bush's defense of President Nixon's policies while Bush served as the United States Ambassador to the United Nations. President Eisenhower features prominently in the collection since Richard Nixon served as his Vice President but the correspondence becomes more personal in nature as Nixon's daughter, Julie Nixon, and Eisenhower's grandson, Dwight David ("David") Eisenhower II, become engaged. Also included in this subject guide are wreath-laying requests for the gravesites of previous Presidents, from George Washington to Lyndon Johnson.

Thirty folders in the Presidents Club Collection contain resources which discuss Presidential funerals due to Harry Truman, Lyndon Johnson, and Dwight Eisenhower all having passed away during Richard Nixon's presidency.

Letters in the Post-Presidential collections illustrate the distance later presidents tried to put between themselves and Richard Nixon after his resignation, but letters near the end of Nixon's life illustrate respect and even fondness between the Presidents. President Reagan's letters are particularly kind as he consistently sent Nixon birthday greetings every year until Nixon's passing in 1994. This collection also contains letters offering condolence to Richard Nixon after the passing of Pat Nixon in June 1993 from the five living Presidents at that time: Gerald Ford, Jimmy Carter, Ronald Reagan, George H. W. Bush, and Bill Clinton.

This subject guide seeks to list resources that show:

- Personal and professional relationships between Nixon and other U.S. Presidents before, during, and after their various presidencies.
- Emphasis on Nixon's role at Eisenhower's Vice President and Ford's role as Nixon's Vice President.
- Funerals as celebrations of presidential lives, including the funerals of Hoover, Eisenhower, Truman, Johnson, and Nixon himself.

• Photos and other audiovisual materials which show U.S. Presidents interacting with President Nixon.
