Conversation No. 55-4

President: Good morning. Uh, would you like to begin with, uh, questions? First, uh, I guess, a brief, uh, reference to the fact that I, uh, all the members [unintelligible] here [unintelligible] [room noise] [unintelligible] the broadcast went very well. But does anybody [unintelligible]? You see [unintelligible] the cost of living.

Connally: No, sir, no.

Ford: I thought the military and the police did an exceptionally good job on this.

President: A military person, they always do. This police chief should become, be a star with publicity. Hell, anyone could.

Unknown: Um-hum.

President: The thing is, you never know what, how a chief's gonna handle his fellows in a really difficult situation. He just did a superb job. Jerry, nothing ever works unless you've got the top man [unintelligible] in charge of the [unintelligible] overall departments. You just have gotta [unintelligible] and these people are all good sports. I was down to, uh, to visit the Washington police headquarters a coupla weeks ago to go to their headquarters to see [unintelligible]. It's just like these people out here demonstrating, except that they [unintelligible] but most of them have not [unintelligible] at least a high school education [unintelligible] radical school in Washington [unintelligible] but, uh, uh, uh, [unintelligible] handle themselves with such discretion [unintelligible] bridges [unintelligible] people that young.
