Transcript #1: Part of a conversation among President Nixon, John D. Ehrlichman, and George W. Romney in the Oval Office between 3:37 pm and 4:14 pm on April 23, 1971.

Conversation No. 487-22#1

President: We may want to do it as a [unintelligible]. Well, frankly, once the demonstrations which are gonna [unintelligible] over, when you can really make news with it, you see --

Romney: Yeah.

President: -- you can't compete sometimes with the other news --.

Conversation No. 487-22#2

President: Well, we have to survive it. We, uh, and they handled it all right. Did you --?

Volpe: Well, that's --.

President: We have it right now and for the next couple weeks we gotta go against these damn demonstrations again --

Volpe: Yeah, this is --.

President: -- and not, not lose our heads --

Volpe: No.

President: -- and not panic 'n' we will --.
