Haldeman: Something I just noticed in the, the *Record* highlights -- Ford, Arends, Coburn, Kyl, Abbott, Sikes, [unintelligible] Waggoner, 'n' Daniel, and Montgomery -- all praised the, the, uh, law enforcement [unintelligible] demonstrators and criticized media coverage on the, on this whole --.

President: Media coverages?

Haldeman: [Unintelligible] did a great job on, he, he hit Muskie.

President: Yeah, uh --.

Haldeman: Got on TV with it. He did it again up on the Hill.

President: Did he?
