Part of a telephone conversation between President Nixon in the Oval Office and Mrs. Jerry Wilson at an unknown time between 5:45 pm and 6:03 pm on May 5, 1971.

Conversation No. 2-93

President: I wanted to congratulate you on your fifteenth wedding anniversary.

Wilson: Well, thank you.

President: I don't think your husband'll get home, but, if he does, why, you tell him that we think that he's all done a splendid job down there and, uh, the whole, uh, city and I think the nation's very proud of what he's done.

Wilson: Well, thank you very much, sir.

President: Fine, goodbye.

Wilson: Bye.
