Conversation No. 2-143

President: Well, I think the temper of the whole thing should be well-effected, you know.
The, the failure of these demonstrations last week was a plus for us. I think that --

Ford: Right.

President: Don't ya think, find a better mood among our guys as a result of that, I would, I would hope so.

Ford: And as a result, I don't think we're going to see the efforts tomorrow in a meaningful way [unintelligible].

President: You don't. Um-hum.

Ford: Now there'll be an effort, I'm sure, but it --

President: Yeah.

Ford: -- I don't think that it [unintelligible].

President: Good. Okay, Jerry, thank you.
