Part of a telephone conversation between President Nixon in the Oval Office and Betty Garcia between 10:52 am and 10:55 am on May 7, 1971.

Conversation No. 2-119

President: Yeah, when you talk to the Senator, you just tell him I called. I was reading my, my news summary, and I noted he stepped up to some of these, uh, these, uh, little friends we had around here this, yesterday on the floor and I appreciate it.

Garcia: Well, I'm sure gonna tell him that.

President: Course I thought, uh, it was disgraceful the way they, uh, they, they threw paint on his door 'n' everything at, uh, we can always count on him to stand up, can't we?

Garcia: We sure can, and we can always count on you, too.
