Part of a telephone conversation between President Nixon in the Oval Office and John A. Mulcahy between 10:35 am and 10:38 am on April 23, 1971.

Conversation No. 2-33

President: And, uh, just incidentally, I, uh, what do ya think of these, uh, these, uh, what they ca-, veterans that are demonstratin' up here?

Mulcahy: Ahh, it's unbelievable. I suppose you'll always have --

President: Right.

Mulcahy: -- a very, very small minority --.

President: Yeah.

Mulcahy: It, it --

President: Yeah, well, most of them there don't feel that way.

Mulcahy: I, I, I, I think you're, you're handling it a-, properly, if I may say so, just a, it'll, it'll run its course.

President: Sure, well, we'll just continue to do the right thing.

Mulcahy: Good. Well, God bless you, Mr. --.

President: Thank, thank, thank you, Jack, and good luck.
