MEMORANDUM FOR PAT BUCHANAN

From Rose Mary Woods *RMW*

Yesterday a longtime supporter of the President who used to live in Washington State and now lives in Newport Beach, California, called me about the forthcoming marriage of Bill Lawrence.

Jack Thomas (the friend) said that the woman Bill is to marry on August 20th in LaJolla is a good friend of theirs and of Peggy and Barry Goldwater. Peggy Goldwater is going to be a witness for the ceremony as a matter of fact. The point he thought was interesting is that this woman for a couple of months told Bill Lawrence she would not marry him unless he became more favorable to the President.
