Having seen that incredible letter dated June 15 as authored by Bill Rentschler, I can say now, I have seen the most presumptuous and egotistical communication of my lifetime.


This man, as I told you long ago, Rose Mary, is incredible. In fact, what I would like to say about him wouldn't be transmitted through the postal services of the United States.
