Several scheduled proposals and materials have gone by regarding the proposal to have one of the First Family (probably Tricia) make a trip to Maine for Senator Margaret Chase Smith.

Jeb Magruder called me this morning to emphasize that it was John Mitchell's firm opinion that this would be a mistake. According to Mitchell, the policy is not to send a member of the First Family into a state where there is a primary challenge. This applies to Margaret Chase Smith in Maine. According to Magruder, Mitchell wants Bob to re-raise the subject with the President to be sure that the event is turned off in light of the firm policy.

Would you have this subject raised in your next series of proposals for First Family schedule? If that opportunity for you to discuss the material with Bob will not be in the next few days, would you send me the necessary back-up so that I can cover the point with Bob?
