Saturday, April 10.

The President at Camp David; I was at Williamsburg. He called around noon to raise the point of getting Phil Watts to do something about the reaction to the despicable conduct of the group from the church that demonstrated yesterday. Also wanted Dole to hit O'Brien on taking the paper on, on the ABC equal time question. He still had a good reaction to the Wednesday speech and the Calley thing. He feels he's got the Democrats confused and was delighted that Muskie was out on the limb in favor of the demonstration coming up April 24.
