Saturday, September 4.

President called this morning from Camp David, mainly to check in. Say that the trip had gone extremely well yesterday, and he felt that the huge crowds, both in Chicago and Dayton, had to have some effect on the psychology of the press, that there was really massive enthusiasm. He's all set at Camp David for the weekend, has Nell Yates up there to handle typing, and so on, of the speech. Rose stayed out here because of serious sickness, and Marge Acker's staying out with her. He was also especially pleased that the market had taken a big bounce upward yesterday.
