Monday, December 20.

We were still on the Kissinger problem some today, as the President talked with me on the plane about the need to get Henry straightened out. He told me to talk with Scali, because Kissinger had raised with the President the point that Scali knows who at State was putting out the India-Pakistan stuff, and the President wanted me to discuss all this with Scali. We're still in the area where Henry is really uptight on all this stuff. He didn't go down with us, since he went to Bermuda last night to meet with Heath ahead of time and get things set up. The Heath meetings and dinner apparently all went pretty well and basically according to form with no major diversions.
