Sunday, March 26.

President stayed at Camp David all day and for dinner. Called in the morning to see if there was anything new. Got back into the discussion of press conference tactics, and feels he ought to go every two weeks on television now, but then gets into the point that there's a problem with doing television on April 6 because of Wisconsin Primary and the unemployment figures that week. It's not really the best week. I argued that we can't base it on that kind of thing that he's got to plan on going on TV whenever he does it, because we get a good audience for it and we waste it by doing it in the office.
