Friday, April 14, in Canada.

The President was involved all morning in the general sessions. He had me over in late afternoon for a short time, mainly follow-up on reaction to the visit so far, a little concerned about the demonstrators. And he wanted to check on domestic stuff; ITT, San Diego Convention moves, that sort of thing.

The evening event was a concert followed by supposedly a very brief handshaker, then the President was to leave, but Trudeau sandbagged him into staying for a buffet supper. Seated him at a table with a place card and kept him there for an hour. President handled it pretty well and I blew up at the Canadians, and we finally got him moved out.
