Saturday, June 10.

The President spent the day at the EOB. Had a long session with Colson, a long session with Al Haig and then had me over for about three hours. Talking mainly about politics. That we need to develop an opposition strategy. The question of how Buchanan's ideas and his excellent McGovern memo will be implemented. Can we get some troops fired up and working on our side, we need to build the idea that we expect McGovern to move up in the polls after the nomination. We need to make the point that his election is the clearest choice we ever had. We should work on building some kid support, especially high school for pizzazz. This was mainly just a long talk sort of rambling over the ground and nothing specific.
