Saturday, August 12.

President had Carlucci come up to-- We had Carlucci come up to Camp David this afternoon to set him up for taking over the disaster coordination at Wilkes-Barre, making the point that he conferred with the President at Camp David first. We had a general discussion with President and Ehrlichman in the Laurel office afterwards, agreed that we'd go ahead on Van Deusen. Discussed the general political need for including Rogers in-- well for setting up planning sessions and strategy sessions. He thinks that Rogers and Laird from time to time should be brought in to the senior strategy sessions, that they should be told the President suggested they sit in to appraise the situation. He thinks we should set up a regular weekly retreat at Camp David, that provide a long time. The President wouldn't sit in, but might have dinner with the group. Suggests that we include Barbara Franklin, or maybe some other woman.
