Saturday, September 9.

President went to Camp David yesterday afternoon, after the 1701 visit, spent the night there, and was there all day today. I had no contact with him. Ehrlichman did call this morning, to suggest that the President, on an unannounced basis, helicopter from Camp David over to Wilkes Barre, and make his visit there so that it'll be done, and we can go ahead and campaign in Pennsylvania. They set it up, did it, and apparently it came off extremely well, so that turned out to be a good move.
