I omitted so it's in this point out of place.

The President covered a bunch of quick odds and ends. He wants to have Rose start doing some phone calls to old friends, etcetera. Wants to, plan to drive back part way from Philadelphia, get some time on the ground. Wants to add radio talks in Chicago and Denver, so there will be something substantive. He doesn't think that we need radio on the last weekend, said okay on a convoy to Ashland, Kentucky. He very definitely wants to go ahead with that trip. He wanted to have Colson to sit in on the Shultz meeting at Camp David, but Colson couldn't, he's going to be at some dinner in New York. He got Colson and me into talking about the issues for the last two weeks: he feels that the main one is, the whole Vietnam complex, bugout, amnesty and so forth; and the other is welfare and taxes; and the other thing is to cut our losses on corruption, economics, and so forth. He wants MacGregor to get and warn hard, on last minute smears that will be coming in towards the end of the campaign.
