Sunday, November 5.

I didn't go into the office today. The President did call a couple of times, he was disappointed in the Massachusetts poll which now shows us 10 points behind. And that raises a question about some of the other polls, but as we reviewed Gallup, Harris and all, they came out about where we'd want them. He decided to drop his scheduled activity for the weekend. He's already dropped church, now he's dropping the headquarters idea and the phone calls, wants wires sent instead. He agreed to do his taping on Monday about 11:00. He's called Hall, Fitzsimmons and Meany and wants telegrams sent to the rest of the people. Some talk of answering the McGovern attack, but, a decision to stay right where we were still.
