Thursday, November 23.

President called this morning on a couple of quick items. He was concerned about the Dole story buildup and about Elmer Bobst with the schedule request Elmer has in for the President to do his hospital dedication. Wanted me to take care of those.

Then he called late this evening, following up Henry's cable, wanted to know who he could talk to to send a cable back to Henry. I told him Colonel Kennedy. And Kennedy called me a few minutes later, a little concerned about the cable, because it in effect tells Henry to make a settlement regardless of what the South Vietnamese think, and that had Kennedy somewhat worried, but he's going ahead with it.
