Sunday, February 4.

The President at Camp David all day today. I was in Washington, had no contact with him. The Vice President called from Singapore, saying he wanted to know what the President's plans and whereabouts would be, that he has to go on now to Djakarta, Kuala Lumpur, and has added Manila. Therefore, he'd be back on the 10th or 11th and wondered where he should meet the President. I told him the President's present plan was to be in California at that time, and I was sure that he could meet there and then the Vice President could stay over for his Lincoln day address on the 12th. He said he was very encouraged by what he was finding, especially in South Vietnam, but that, of course, it all hangs on how well Henry's trip goes. He thinks the Laos situation looks good, among other things.
