Saturday, February 17.

The President's in Key Biscayne. I've had no contact except a phone call at 10:00 this morning, which was sort of a general review. He wanted to know what the plan was for his South Carolina trip on Tuesday, and the necessary background for that. Thinks the trip sounded good, their getting across the point that people are enthusiastic. He reviewed this week and felt it was a good thing we came back from California. He got a lot of good things done and it was worthwhile.

That was about it.

Ehrlichman called to say that they'd had a good meeting with Brennan on the plane, got things going pretty well on that, so that may be in better shape now.
