Sunday, April 1.

The big deal today was Weicker on *Face the Nation*, where he hit me pretty hard on knowledge of Watergate and that's the lead out of his thing. He seems to think I had directed a master plot of sabotage and espionage, of which Watergate was only a minor part. He admitted he didn't have any evidence, but that didn't seem to stop him. We had some discussion today. The President called Ehrlichman several times but did not call me on the subject. I guess he did call once this morning while I was out to breakfast, but missing me, talked to John and then maintained his contact with John the rest of the day. We didn't go into the office.
