Saturday, January 9.

The President still at San Clemente, and I'm still at Palm Springs. It was his birthday. I called him in the morning to wish him a happy birthday and check out a few details on the proposed Nebraska stop, which we agreed on and are now going to go ahead and set it.

Also, we viewed Mitchell's Republican National Committee plans, which he covered with me last night, and which were okay with the President, going ahead to make Tom Evans Co-Chairman, although the President suggested Co-Chairman for Organization and Pat Hitt as Vice Chairman.

The President feels we do need to move to clean out all of the sub-organization types at the Committee, though, and not leave the same old structure there.

He got talked into a walk on the beach for a birthday picture by Ziegler, and it didn't come out too well, but didn't do any great harm, I guess. We don't seem to be able to set up a system where we leave him alone as we've tried to do here.
