Tuesday, January 12.

The President in San Clemente. I'm still in Palm Springs. I've had no contact with him all day. He decided this morning to get to work on the State of the Union, and issued orders that he was not to be disturbed for 48 hours, and, as far as I know, has been holed up ever since. It's been raining in San Clemente, so it's a good day for him to be locked up and working.

It's been cloudy here at Palm Springs, too, and I spent the whole day in the room working on the analysis of the Presidential image, etcetera, with the books that have been stacked up waiting to get into.
