Saturday, March 29.

Back to Camp David on chopper with Rose, Ray, Ron and Chapin after morning in office getting details cleared up. President not feeling well, had been in bed all day - stayed there until late afternoon, then called for Ray to work on eulogy. Called me over at 6:30 for about an hour - discussed funeral plans and a few papers he had to review. Still not feeling well – bronchitis - and talked with Bebe quite a bit about need for more rest. Hope maybe this setback will convince him. Was sitting by the window again, light snow falling outside, fire crackling, dinner set for two in front of fire. We had our dinner at the lodge, then saw a lousy movie. Should have gone to bed. President stayed up pretty late working on speech. Ray over from 9:30 until 10 or 11.
