Kept the afternoon clear for possible Friday press conference - so long sessions of odds and ends. He took a long nap in the little office.

Wants to stop all use of Brookings because they are Kennedy people. Pushing hard on ABM organization. Wants to ride on student statement - get weekend push. Ehrlichman worried about Mitchell hard line speech, but President wants him to go ahead.

I left in late afternoon for California. President called while I was in air, left message. At 11:00 p.m. EDT I called, he was worried about Mrs. Doyle confusion regarding Oval Office.
