Leadership meeting, and some odds and ends. Most of the day with Kissinger regarding trip and Vietnam. Really pushing hard on one-third cut of overseas personnel.

Didn't like small dinner last night for astronauts. Thinks it's just as much trouble as a big one, with less gain

Some chat regarding reorganization of staff. Mad as hell regarding meeting this morning with Congressmen, added at last minute and not adequately staffed. Volpe pressured Harlow.

Moynihan was also furious, and was in and out of my office all day fuming. Big flap regarding DC crime - Senator Tydings made speech saying nothing done.
