Tuesday, August 19.

Pretty active morning. Ehrlichman and me, then Kissinger. Then a meeting with Wallace Sterling regarding Bicentennial Commission. Then the new Indian Commissioner, then six new Ambassadors.

Concerned about Ziegler telling press about his golf, and having them follow him around. Still trying to get some freedom and privacy. Also wants aides to find a sandy beach for swimming - unfortunately the rocks (boulders) on his beach make it almost useless.

Discussed idea of Borman in for White House staff. President still wants him. Thinks he has the intuitive feel to do the PR job he wants. Maybe so.

Off to Palma with Mitchell for today's golf. Called on return for report. Nothing happening. Then called while we were at Pavilion for dinner asking us down for movies. Turned out no one was there with him tonight. Pat Nixon at Drowns, kids out, Ehrlichman unavailable, as was Rose, so Manolo said just he and Fina there. Sad.
