Thursday, August 21.

President trip to San Francisco for Korea State Visit. I didn't go. At staff meeting in morning he said Drowns had stayed for dinner and through most of the evening. He had his session with them – they just wanted to get back into good graces. He says he was tough – but I don't think he really was.

Then off to San Francisco. Apparently all was OK except for demonstrators at the St. Francis - who were really obscene, and could be heard in the meetings. President was quite disturbed by them and ordered Chapin and Ehrlichman to take all kinds of action, and demanded that Alioto give President Park a letter of apology.
