President had appointments in the morning. Blount, and then his postal reform group, Thrus Morton and Larry O' Brien. Then Rudy Peterson regarding AID then Sam Yorty. That was it.

In afternoon President asked Kissinger, Ehrlichman and me to come to beach at Pendleton for a swim. He drove off without us. Then when we arrived at trailer and went on to change, the President disappeared up the beach. Left us sitting one and a half hours. Then came back and we all went for a long cold windy walk. President talking about all kinds of things, including how lovely the beach cliffs would be as setting for hotels and condominiums. Good grief!
