Saturday, September 20.

At Camp David. President slept late. We left at noon. Had to wait a while on chopper while they tried to find Vicki. Reception in East Room for student body and college presidents. President disturbed afterwards - felt it was useless, and that we should not have done it. One kid gave him a lecture on how to be a good president and start leading the country - this set him off. Another example, maybe, of our letting the bad guys use us as a forum. We'll see how the press comes out and how the kids react.

Then he had an appointment with Bob Hope, and after saying yesterday he could not play golf ever on Saturday, they went off to Burning Tree for the afternoon.
