Friday, October 24.

Full morning - breakfast with Speaker and Majority Leader, meeting with Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board; appointments with Senator Fang, Ampac leaders, Frank Pace about educational TV, Kendall and Lynn Townsend regarding NAB. Afternoon supposed to be clear for speech work. Spent most of it talking to Kissinger, Ehrlichman, me, on general matters.

Still pushing hard on narcotics follow-up. Yesterday's meeting made a strong impression. Has a steady flow of ideas on how to capitalize. Also really pondering the Lindsay race. *New York News* poll shows him way ahead, but behind Procaccino and Marchi combined. President obviously very anxious to see him beaten, but can't get into the Marchi maneuver that might do it.

Spent quite a little time with Rose and me on dinner list for Prince Philip, and in general. Mainly for therapy for Rose I think. Kissinger trotted Arlene Dahl in at one point.

At 5:40 President called me in to say he'd go to Camp David at 6:00, after three days of my trying to get a decision. He went – alone - says he'll work on speech and needs no staff. Hope it works!
