Thursday, October 30.

Morning full of appointments, GOP ethnic group, launched consumer program, Senator Smith, etc. Long meeting with Kissinger and Laird, Mitchell, Rogers to get them lined up regarding speech. Getting all his groundwork laid. Really pleased with new Gallup that shows 58 percent approve his handling of the war, up from 52 percent before the Moratorium.

Long talk regarding life in general, Agnew in particular. Is determined not to let them drive a wedge, in spite of flack regarding VP speeches. Everyone stirred up about Supreme Court decision to integrate immediately, but President just smiled and said "let's see how they enforce it."
