Friday, October 31.

Mainly speech preparation. No appointment schedule. President spent most of the day at EOB - a little time on the Latin America speech for tonight. Mostly on Vietnam. Scheduled a 2:00 haircut and got so absorbed that he forgot to go over for it. Very pleased with Sunday's Gallup poll (shows him in 58 percent approval on Vietnam), lots of orders to get maximum mileage out of this, to build momentum.

Did the speech tonight on TV for South America, radio here. Then headed from the banquet to Camp David, by chopper, which was fogged out and had to land at Thurmont, and he drove up.
