Sunday, November 30.

Again quiet - President called once while I was at church but didn't call back. Did talk to Ehrlichman - was now totally unhappy with hunger speech, and wants it rewritten. He had called me Friday wanting Arthur to check the statistics, but said otherwise it was OK. Arthur called me today to say statistics were all wrong, and he was very glad President was having the speech rewritten.

Alex called after they returned - President had gone right to the office. Wants tomorrow's schedule cleared so he can work on the speech. Is apparently now putting more significance on it.
