Sunday, December 7.

President at Camp David all day and overnight. Snow. He called in the afternoon - just checking on plan for Farm Bureau drop-by tomorrow, wants it later, will not come down until noon or after. Asked about follow-up reaction on the football game yesterday. Rambled on a bit about what he wants to cover with farmers - asked for material to be sent up there by noon tomorrow, and that was it.

Interesting that as he prepares for press conference, he takes a lot of time and works hard at it, but seems quite relaxed, not uptight at all, as he used to be during preparation for a speech, i.e., acceptance or even Inaugural. Definitely is more on top of it, and taking it in stride.
